**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, APPROVING THE RELEASE OF SPECIAL TAX BILLS CONCERNING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF MARSHALL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marshall has issued special tax bills in the total sum of approximately \$12,000.00 on real property located at 524 East Washington Street, Marshall, Saline County, Missouri (hereinafter, the "Property"); and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that the Property will be transferred to Terry and Monyette Browder, husband and wife, and adjacent property owners.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the City of Marshall, by and through its City Administrator, or his designee, shall issue and record one or more Release of Special Tax Bills for the purpose of release special tax bills it has issued against the Property, commonly known as 524 East Washington Street, Marshall, Saline County, Missouri, upon the transfer of the Property to Terry and Monyette Browder. Said Release shall not be issued unless and until the Property is transferred by an appropriate deed to Terry and Monyette Browder.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BURNS & MCDONNELL ENGINEERING CO., INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marshall (“City”), by and through its Board of Public Works, and Burns & McDonnell Engineering Co. Inc., entered into an Agreement dated June 21, 2021, pertaining to the North Street Pump Station Improvements Project (the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to execute a further agreement for the purpose of entering into Phase 3 of the Project.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of said City an Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Co., Inc., for the purpose of entering Phase 3 of the North Street Pump Station Improvements Project and for such other work as specified in said Agreement. The contract price for the said Contract shall be Three Million Four Hundred Seventy-one Thousand One Hundred Sixty and 00/100ths Dollars (\$3,471,160.00), and such other sums as may be set forth in said Agreement.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, BY PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF CERTAIN CITY STREETS**

WHEREAS, the City of Marshall, Missouri ("City") has determined that it is beneficial to prohibit parking on certain portions of certain City streets as more fully set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** The City's traffic ordinances shall be amended as follows:

- a. The parking of vehicles on the east side of Salt Pond Avenue from Arrow Street to College Street shall be prohibited.
- b. The parking of vehicles on the west side of Miami Avenue from Arrow Street to Vest Street shall be prohibited.
- c. The parking of vehicles on the west side of English Avenue from Arrow Street to Vest Street shall be prohibited.
- d. The parking of vehicles on the south side of High Street from Miami Avenue to English Avenue shall be prohibited.
- e. The parking of vehicles on the south side of Hanie Street from English Avenue to Jefferson Avenue and on the north side of Hanie Street from English Avenue to a point one hundred fifty feet (150') east of English Avenue shall be prohibited.
- f. The parking of vehicles on the south side of Ohio Street from English Avenue to Lafayette Avenue and on the north side of Ohio Street from English Avenue to a point one hundred fifty feet (150') east of English Avenue shall be prohibited.

**Section 2.** The City shall place and maintain signs giving notice of this amendment to the City's traffic ordinances and this ordinance shall not be effective unless such signs are in place.

**Section 3.** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. In all other respects, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri shall remain unchanged.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARSHALL AND RTS WASTE SERVICES LLC FOR THE PROVISION OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES IN THE CITY OF MARSHALL.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marshall seeks to contract with RTS Waste Services LLC for the collection of solid waste in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that competitive negotiations through discussion and bargaining provide the best value to the City, time is a crucial factor, and there is inherent economy in contracting with RTS Waste Services LLC in that it enhanced the City's ability to procure solid waste collection services in a more efficient and cost-effective manner.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of said City an agreement with RTS Waste Services LLC, for the provision by RTS of solid waste collection services within the City, and in consideration of the work completed under the agreement by RTS Waste Services LLC, the City shall pay RTS Waste Services LLC, such sums as are specified in the agreement, with the said payments being made at such time or times as required by the agreement.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.
