

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
OCTOBER 3, 2022  
6:00 P.M.**

The Marshall City Council met in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 3, 2022, in the Council Chambers of the City Office Building, 214 N. Lafayette, Marshall, MO 65340, with the following members present: Mayor Dewey Hendrix; Council Members Leon Thompson, Tim Reeder, Robert Ashford, Charles Guthrey, Craig Thompson, Dan Brandt and Steve Cook; City Administrator JD Kehrman, City Counselor Josh Taylor and City Clerk Julie Lewis. Council Member Drew Green excused absent.

Council Member Reeder made a motion, seconded by Leon Thompson, to adopt the agenda as written. A roll call vote was taken with Brandt, Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey and Craig Thompson voting aye; Green excused absent. Motion carried.

Council Member Brandt made a motion, seconded by Ashford, to approve the Regular Session Minutes of September 19, 2022, Work Session Minutes of September 26, 2022, Special Session Minutes of September 26, 2022 and Special Session Minutes of September 29, 2022. A roll call vote was taken with Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey, Craig Thompson and Brandt voting aye; Green excused absent. Motion carried.

**MUNICIPAL SERVICES AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:**

Council Member Brandt gave the following Storm Water Tip:

Sweep up grass clippings, fallen leaves, fruits and shrub trimmings and keep Them out of the storm drain system. Use fallen leaves a mulch or for composting.

**CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:**

City Administrator JD Kehrman reported on the following:

The Municipal Services Committee will be identifying and discussing upcoming street projects and putting bid specifications together for those projects. Storm water projects will also be discussed.

Remco will be on-site mid October to begin demolition of the old hospital building located on Brunswick Avenue.

Attended the public meeting conducted by the Park Board regarding the Park Master Plan.

Mr. Kehrman said he is working with Mr. Tom McRoberts regarding a proposed trail system and that will be presented at the next Park Board meeting.

The Department of Natural Resources has granted clearance to the demolition contractor that will be taking down the building on Arrow Street.

## **ORDINANCES**

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUNDS” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Reeder made a motion, seconded by Ashford, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey, Craig Thompson, Brandt, Cook and Leon Thompson voting aye; Green excused absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8705 entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUNDS” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Guthrey, seconded by Thompson. A roll call vote was taken with Ashford, Guthrey, Craig Thompson, Brandt, Cook, Leon Thompson and Reeder voting aye; Green excused absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

## **OTHER COUNCIL BUSINESS**

There being no other Council Business, Council Member Reeder made a motion, seconded by Ashford, to adjourn the meeting. A roll call vote was taken with Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey, Craig Thompson, Brandt and Cook voting aye; Green excused absent. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 6:11 p.m.
