

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SPECIAL SESSION
SEPTEMBER 29, 2022
12:00 P.M.**

The Marshall City Council met in Special Session at 12:15 p.m. on Thursday, September 29, 2022 in the Council Chamber of the City Office Building, 214 N. Lafayette, Marshall, MO 65340, with the following members present: Mayor Dewey Hendrix; Council Members Leon Thompson, Tim Reeder, Robert Ashford, Charles Guthrey and Steve Cook; City Administrator JD Kehrman and City Clerk Julie Lewis. Council Members Dan Brandt and Drew Green excused absent; Council Member Craig Thompson absent.

Council Member Ashford made a motion, seconded by Leon Thompson, to adopt the agenda as written. A roll call vote was taken with Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford and Guthrey voting aye; Brandt and Green excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. Motion carried.

ORDINANCES

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 8625 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Reeder made a motion, seconded by Guthrey, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford and Guthrey voting aye; Green and Brandt excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8702 entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 8625 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Reeder, seconded by Leon Thompson. A roll call vote was taken with Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey and Cook voting aye; Green and Brandt excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BUDGET FOR 2022-2023 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON THE FINANCES FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AND ESTABLISHING ALL SALARIES AS SET OUT IN SAID BUDGET” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Leon Thompson said the Finance Committee had three goals – the first is to provide a balanced budget, the second is to be more reflective of actual spending and the third is to be reflective of our leadership.

Council Member Leon Thompson made a motion, seconded by Reeder, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey, Cook and Leon

Thompson voting aye; Green and Brandt excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8703 entitled “AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BUDGET FOR 2022-2023 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON THE FINANCES FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AND ESTABLISHING ALL SALARIES AS SET OUT IN SAID BUDGET” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Reeder, seconded by Leon Thompson. A roll call vote was taken with Reeder, Ashford, Guthrey, Cook and Leon Thompson voting aye; Green and Brandt excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUNDS” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Ashford made a motion, seconded by Reeder, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Ashford, Guthrey, Cook, Leon Thompson and Reeder voting aye; Brandt and Green excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8704 entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUNDS” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Guthrey, seconded Reeder. A roll call vote was taken with Guthrey, Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder and Ashford voting aye; Brandt and Green excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

OTHER COUNCIL BUSINESS

There being no other Council Business, Council Member Reeder made a motion, seconded by Ashford, to adjourn the meeting. A roll call vote was taken with Cook, Leon Thompson, Reeder, Ashford and Guthrey voting aye; Brandt and Green excused absent; Craig Thompson absent. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 12:21 p.m.
