

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
SPECIAL SESSION  
SEPTEMBER 27, 2024  
12:00 P.M.**

The Marshall City Council met in Special Session at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 27, 2024, in the Council Chambers of the City Office Building, 214 N. Lafayette, Marshall, MO 65340, with the following members present: Mayor Vincent Lutterbie; Council Members Jim Papreck, Craig Thompson, Nathan Swisher and Steve Cook; City Counselor Elizabeth Bellamy and City Clerk Julie Lewis; Council Members John Allen and Dan Brandt present via videoconference. Council Members Green and Guthrey excused absent.

Council Member Papreck made a motion, seconded by Thompson, to adopt the agenda as written. A voice vote was taken with all in attendance in favor; Green and Guthrey excused absent. Motion carried.

**ORDINANCES**

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 8785 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Thompson made a motion, seconded by Papreck, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Swisher, Brandt, Cook, Papreck, Thompson and Allen voting aye; Green and Guthrey excused absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8852 entitled “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 8785 OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS SUBMITTED FOR SAID CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Papreck, seconded by Swisher. A roll call vote was taken with Brandt, Cook, Papreck, Thompson, Allen and Swisher voting aye; Green and Guthrey excused absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

An ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUNDS” was given its first reading by title only.

Council Member Papreck made a motion, seconded by Thompson, to take the ordinance to a second reading. A roll call vote was taken with Cook, Papreck, Thompson, Allen, Swisher and Brandt voting aye; Green and Guthrey excused absent. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 8853 entitled “AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS OUT OF THE DIFFERENT CITY FUND” was given its second reading by title only and put to its final passage and approval upon motion of Thompson, seconded by Papreck. A roll call vote was taken with Papreck, Thompson, Allen, Swisher,

Brandt, and Cook voting aye; Green and Guthrey excused absent. The ordinance is thereupon declared passed and so endorsed by the President of the Council and approved by the Mayor.

**OTHER COUNCIL BUSINESS**

There being no other Council Business, Council Member Cook made a motion, seconded by Brandt, to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken with all in attendance in favor; Green and Guthrey excused absent. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 12:07 p.m.
