**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO CLARIFY ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY BY INCLUDING REFERENCES TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT.**

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri (the “Code”), contains provisions referring to the Board of Code Enforcement as the primary enforcement authority for certain violations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to clarify that enforcement of code violations may also be pursued through the City of Marshall, Missouri Municipal Court, as authorized by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.**

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby amended to provide that wherever the “Board of Code Enforcement” is referenced as an enforcement or adjudicative authority, the reference shall be interpreted to include “and/or the City of Marshall, Missouri Municipal Court,” as contextually appropriate.

**Section 2.**

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to limit or eliminate the authority of the Board of Code Enforcement as currently provided in the Code of Ordinances. This Ordinance shall be interpreted as expanding, rather than restricting, the enforcement mechanisms available to the City.

**Section 3.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO AUTHORIZE NOTICE BY POSTING ON THE PROPERTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri (the “Code”) requires various forms of notice to be given to property owners or occupants in connection with the enforcement of codes, regulations, or orders; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that posting notice directly on the property is a reasonable, effective, and necessary method to ensure timely and adequate notice when other forms of delivery may be impractical or ineffective; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to amend the Code to expressly permit notice to be given by posting on the affected property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby amended to provide that wherever the Code requires notice to be given, such notice may also be given by posting the notice on the subject property in a conspicuous location, in addition to or in lieu of other forms of notice, unless otherwise expressly prohibited by state law or a specific provision of the Code.

**Section 2.**

This Ordinance shall not be construed to eliminate any other required method of notice where such method is mandated by state statute or federal law. This Ordinance is intended to supplement, not replace, existing notice requirements unless explicitly revised.

**Section 3.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
