Vote April 7, 2026



The City of Marshall is asking citizens to vote on a half-cent sales tax measure to fund street and sidewalk maintenance and improvements. If passed, the half-cent sales tax will generate an anticipated \$1 million annually, allowing Marshall to fulfill its responsibility to maintain the streets and sidewalks our community depends on.

What You're Voting For

Funding for much needed repairs and maintenance of our existing streets and sidewalks.

An estimated \$3 million over three years specifically for transportation projects.

A Tax with Built in Guardrails

The tax will expire in 2029 and would have to be reapproved by the voters at that time to continue.

By law revenues from this tax can only be used for streets and sidewalks.



The Facts

The proposed sales tax is a half-cent (0.5%) tax dedicated to transportation .

A half-cent sales tax means 50¢ for every \$100 spent - that's 2¢ on a \$4 cup of coffee.

The tax applies to all retail purchases in Marshall, including purchases made by visitors.
