

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri will hold a public hearing at 6:00 P.M., Tuesday, August 18, 2026, prior to the regular council meeting, at the City Office Building, 214 N. Lafayette, Marshall, Missouri, at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, a political subdivision.

The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenues for the budget of the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2026, shows to be required from the property tax. Each tax is determined by dividing the amount of revenue required by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.
